

So You Think You Can Act ***An Evening Packed Full of Entertainment!***

Winnipeg, January 16, 2012– On February 16th at the Gas Station Arts Centre the inaugural *So You Think You Can Act* event will entertain audiences with an array of comic writing by celebrated playwrights. *So You Think You Can Act* is a fun fundraiser supporting the transformative theatre work of Sarasvati Productions. The evening will feature celebrities testing out their acting chops in front of a panel of judges and an audience.

In the fashion of *Dancing with the Stars*, each celebrity will be paired with an actor and given great material. Tracy Koga will be performing a hilarious fast forward through the dating game from the hit musical *I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change*. Lending support as her acting partner will be stage and screen actor Tyhr Trubiak, best known for his lead role in independent film hit *Aegri Somnia*.

David King’s *Life Skills* won a Jessie Award for Best New Play and Al Simmons will certainly bring the humour in the script to life as a man desperately trying to escape his marriage. Audiences will also see local favorite Sylvia Kuzyk in a new light, as a famous actress confronted by her lover’s wife in Ferenc Molnar’s *A Matter of Husbands*.

The other celebrities include: Ace Burpee (Hot 103), Randall King (Winnipeg Free Press), Howard Mandshein (92 CITI FM) and Judy Wasylycia-Leis (former MP). Big laughs will also be guaranteed by host Big Daddy Tazz and judges Kayla Gordon (Winnipeg Studio Theatre Artistic Director), Robert Metcalfe (PTE Artistic Director) and Lee White (Crumbs Improv).

As part of the event a raffle will be held with prizes ranging from tickets to the city’s hottest performing arts events to a free adult acting class at Prairie Theatre Exchange. With donations from dozens of businesses, including Vandenberg’s Fine Jewellery, Sugar Mountain and the Love Nest, there will be thousands of dollars worth of prizes to be won.
